Mission Statement

Primer Academia de ABC para Niños, exists to provide a safe, high quality, developmental environment, with a Spanish language program, providing a stimulating early child care and educational experience, which promotes each child's social, emotional, spiritual, physical and cognitive development. Our objective is to support children desire to be life-long learners, through a cooperative partnership between parents and staff.

Philosophy

Primer Academia de ABC para Niños philosophy is that children will be encouraged to learn and grow by providing a Spanish Immersion program and a foundation of developmentally appropriate experiences where all children can succeed in a safe and nurturing environment, while building independence, self-esteem, and confidence.

Primer Academia de ABC para Niños teachers will provide an early childhood program that allows each child to grow and develop as Jesus did in wisdom and stature and in favor with God and man (Luke 2:52). A child's growth and development is viewed as a process, not an event.

Curriculum

Our Students will learn from a Christian Spanish Curriculum, created by Ana Cardona, Director of the Program. The Curriculum will provide a variety of learning activities to become fluent in Spanish and develop Spanish Conversational Skills. Our Curriculum is designed for your child to learn a second language.

General Policies

ADMISSION

New and current enrolled students are required to submit a completed application form. **A \$90.00 non-refundable registration fee must be paid, per child, per location,** right after you submit the application form. Assignment on days Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday will be on a **first come, first serve basis.** **Registration fee is non-refundable, even if the student does not re-enroll or withdraws.**

MONTHLY TUITION

Monthly tuition is paid per child, per location. Monthly tuition for 2021-2022 school year is \$230, sibling discount \$215 (Except for August & December). Monthly tuition is due the 1st of each month; we charge a late fee of \$25 after the 1st of each month. We are using Brightwheel platform, for payments and messages, after you enroll your child, you will receive instructions on how to set up your Brightwheel account.

Tuition is paid for a spot in the school, NOT for number of days attended. Therefore, no refunds, adjustments, or deductions of any kind shall be made because of absence of any student during the school year or summer program (i.e. illness, snow days, scheduled holidays, early dismissal, etc.)

SIBLING DISCOUNT

We offer a \$15.00 sibling discount, monthly tuition ONLY. We don't offer sibling discount for the months of August & December.

ABSENCES

We ask Parents to notify the Director when a child is to be absent, **no adjustments will be made on the monthly tuition for absences, holidays, vacations, days when School is closed. If your child is absence for a week or more, monthly tuition needs to be paid in full. We do not offer make up days.**

WITHDRAWING

A child's withdrawal from our program requires thirty (30) days written notice to the Director. A child's withdrawal, suspension, or dismissal from the School does not release the person responsible from tuition payments. If there is a child on the waiting list who can fill the vacated spot immediately, payment of tuition may be stopped on the last day attended. **If however, the vacated spot is unable to be filled immediately, tuition for one thirty (30) day payment period is due in full.** Primer Academia de ABC para Niños, does not offer tuition refunds for partial attendance or early withdrawal, in any case.

VIRTUAL CLASSES

In the event that any of our locations or both, have to be closed, for any circumstance of health, pandemic or any other circumstance, and we are unable to meet in our building(s). Virtual classes will begin immediately; **monthly tuition is required to be paid during virtual classes. Tuition is paid for a spot in the school, NOT for number of days attended.**

SUMMER PROGRAM

A non-refundable registration fee is required for summer program, per child, per location. Monthly tuition is due June & July 1st, per child, per location. We have a very active and fun Summer Program, for the months of June and July, hours are from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. Extended care is offered from 1:00 to 2:55 pm, for an extra fee, per child, per location.

CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

Primer Academia de ABC para Niños, offers support to the parents and children with special needs to find the resources, therapies, and will work with them to evaluate their child's care needs and our ability to meet their needs, if it is determined that the child can participate and will be benefit in our program with the curriculum we offer.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Primer Academia de ABC para Niños, opens its doors to students at 9:00 a.m. and ends its class day at 2:00 p.m., during regular School year, and hours during Summer Program are from 9:00 am to 1:00 p.m., we appreciate that every child is supervised by his/her parent or guardian, prior to 9:00 a.m.

SCHOOL CALENDAR

The schedule shall be in close accordance with the Davidson County Schools Calendar. Please visit our website to check it out. www.primeracademiadeabc.com/calendar

BEFORE OR AFTER CARE

We offer before care from 8:00 to 9:00 am and after care from 2:00 to 2:55 pm, during regular School year on a monthly basis. **You can choose only one option**, the fee is due the first day of each month. **Every child needs to be picked up promptly at 2:55 pm, with NO exceptions.** If a child is being picked up after 3:00 for more than 2 times, after care service will be subject to termination. **NO reimbursements will be made.**

ACCIDENT/INJURY REPORT

If an accident occurs we will contact the parent/guardian of the child, to let them know the circumstances of the accident. It will be written and given the accident report to the parent/guardian at pick up time. The child's teacher will review it with the parent/guardian and ask him/her to sign the report, a copy will be given to the parent and the original will be filed for records.

EMERGENCY PERSONS AND ESCORT

If someone, **other than those listed on your registration form**, is to pick up your child from the School on a particular day, a note must be completed and turned to the Director on that morning. **The person picking the child up will need a photo ID and know the "code word" that was written on the application form, and 4-digit Brightwheel code.**

ARRIVAL

At Primer Academia de ABC para Niños, we maintain an active schedule in each classroom. **Drop off is between 8:55 to 9:15 a.m.**, we will not allow students to come in the classrooms after 9:15, unless the student has a Doctor's appointment, which we ask the parents to let the Director know beforehand. **Drop off will be outside of our locations.** Please properly sign your child in electronically every morning through the Brightwheel app. **We will take your child's temperature upon arrival. We are asking ALL parents to wear a mask during drop off & pick up, even if you have been vaccinated. Our staff is required to wear a mask during school hours. Masks for students are optional, based on their parent's decision.**

PICK UP

At Primer Academia de ABC para Niños, we ask all students to be picked up promptly at 2:00 pm during regular School year, and at 1:00 pm during Summer Program. **A late fee of \$1.00 per minute will be charged for children not picked up by the time above described, late pick up fee begins at 2:01 for regular School year and at 1:01 for Summer Program (not to exceed \$45 per day), please pay the fee to your child's teacher or Director at the time you pick up your child. We will use cell phone time as the official time marker.** You will be asked to sign a late pick up form to acknowledge the time of pick up and the corresponding fee.

We will not make any discount for the days you choose to pick up your child early. **Pick up will be outside of our locations.** Please kindly sign your child out electronically through the Brightwheel app every afternoon. **Please wear a mask, even if you have been vaccinated.**

DISCIPLINE

Our discipline policy, guides children in the development of worthy values and developmentally appropriate social skills. We want each student to grow in kindness, honesty, respect and consideration for others. Teachers carefully plan the classroom environment to encourage cooperation and collaboration. The day is carefully orchestrated to provide the routines and consistency children need. A child will be asked to sit quietly to regain self-control and be removed from the activities. One minute per age of child, but children are never completely isolated from others. It is our goal to work with parents and have an effective communication regarding a child's behavior. In extreme situations, we will take the following actions:

- Ask the parents to seek professional guidance.
- Child's suspension
- Termination

SEPARATION AT MORNING DROP-OFF

Children sometimes have difficulty separating from their parents. When you leave your child in our care, please be reassured that our Staff will do their best to get the children's attention to an activity, so they have a smooth transition. When you drop off your child, you may want to see that he is engaged in an activity. However, staying too long will make the separation more difficult. If you are concerned, you may wait out of sight of your child. We will send a picture of your child through the Brighthweel app, once he is happily settled, if he was indecisive or worried when you left. Children generally become eagerly engaged in a classroom activity shortly after a parent leaves, but it is our pleasure to reassure you with a phone call or text.

POTTY TRAINING

We support the Parents to work with their child in the potty training process (**those who are under 3 years old**). Please give to your child's teacher key words that your child will recognize and dress your child in clothing that will allow for as much independence as possible. Please send extra clothes, underwear and shoes, don't be discourage if your child has a potty accident while at School, and remember that accidents are part of the process of learning.

All kids 3 years old and up MUST be fully potty trained, wear regular underwear, NO diapers or pull-ups. If a child has more than 3 accidents we will ask the parent to bring back to school his child until he/she is able to communicate the needs of his body. Portable potty is not allowed, you can send one that folds and fits in your child's backpack.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

In case of severe weather (snow, tornado warnings, etc.) please tune into Snowbird (WSMV Channel 4), or you can call us at 615.300.6720. **No make-up or reimbursement will be made.**

MEDICATIONS

Primer Academia de ABC para Niños's staff is **NOT** authorized to administer any type of medications to the students, only rescue medicines. Epi-pens or other rescue medicine need to be in the original container. A medical release form will be given to the Parents to complete and sign.

GARDENING

From April to October, our students have the opportunity to learn about the great cycle of life. They will take care of the garden daily. We don't use any kind of chemicals or fertilizer for our garden.

INFORMATION

We have a FB closed group for parents ONLY, where we will post pictures/videos and any other information regarding our PDO. We are using the Brightwheel app, for check-in/out our students, messages, daily reports, etc. A monthly newsletter will be emailed so the parents will know what unit theme our students will learn and other activities according to our curriculum.

ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

We offer weekly Art Classes for kids 2 to 5 years old, our students learn about a variety of artists and they work on weekly art projects, during regular School year.

Sport classes are every other week, for kids 2 to 5 years old, during regular School year and summer program. We garden from April to October; our students have a great time learning about vegetables.

As many other enrichment activities we offer to our students.

RECESS

Our students have 20 minutes of daily outdoor recess also they have a daily morning gardening time for about 10 minutes. If it is not raining and temperature is above 50 degrees, the students will go outside.

SNACKS

The School serves a daily healthy snack. Please send a drink.

LUNCH

All our students need to bring a nut-free lunch and a drink daily. **Please send a cup with water; we will gladly refill it if needed. DO NOT send empty cups. Please pack a healthy lunch for your child that does not need to be microwaved or refrigerated.** Please send your entire child's lunch cut and ready to eat in **finger food sizes, fruit already peeled and cut as well. We are a NUT-FREE program.**

Don't forget a spoon or fork, if needed, cut hot dogs and grapes in quarters. We welcome birthday celebrations, please keep in mind our **NUT-FREE** policy when choosing the food for birthday celebrations. **Please send all your baby's bottles ready, we will NOT fix bottles, but we are glad to warm it up if needed.**

BIRTHDAY CELEBRATIONS/SPECIAL EVENTS

Please be advised that for birthday celebrations and special events our students will have cupcakes, cookies, and any other special treat. If you DON'T want your child to eat the special treat, please email the Director to let her know.

NAP & REST TIME

All of our students will have a nap or rest time daily. **Please send a 1" nap mat, nap mat cover sheet and blanket for kids 2 years old and up.** We won't keep your child's nap mat cover and blanket in our PDO, please be advised that our staff will place it in your child's backpack and be mindful to send it back on your child's days of school.

Babies will need to bring a crib sheet and blanket, we won't keep them with us, the teacher will place them in your baby's backpack, please bring them back on your baby's days of school.

HALF DAYS:

The following events, we will be open only half day:
(Please check our School calendar).

Thanksgiving Potluck: Dismissal will be at 11:00 am,

Christmas Program: Will begin at 10:00 am, drop off time will be as normal 9:00 am, dismissal is right after the program.

Graduation: This event will begin at 10:00 am, drop off time will be as normal 9:00 am, dismissal will be right after the event.

SAFETY:

Students who have hair that obstructs their eyes, or any part of their faces, will be asked to cut their hair, also their nails need to be cut, to avoid unnecessary scratches.

DOMESTIC ISSUES

In the event that a domestic issue arises, that might concern our Program, please notify your child's teacher or the Director about the situation. The safety of all our students is our highest priority.

CONDUCT

Our Staff portrays a great example for all of our students, therefore we ask all parents to conduct with respect and kindness when dropping and picking up your child from our Program, if an issue between parents arise, please let the Director know. **We don't allow any yelling, profanity or any misconduct in the Church's facilities or parking lot.** Our policies have been created to offer a clean, safe and enjoyable place for our students, therefore if you don't agree with our policies, please talk with the Director and share your thoughts. **Under any circumstances we will allow a parent to disrespect a teacher, on-site director or the Director in any way, shape or form. We reserve the right to terminate our service for your child, if a situation like that arises.**

VACATION/TRAVELING:

Due to the spread of COVID-19, if you are taking a vacation or traveling, we are asking you to wait 7 days, from the last day of your vacation/travel, to bring your child back to our program, if you have not been vaccinated. The safety of our students and staff is our highest priority!.

UPDATES/CHANGE OF POLICIES:

Our policies are subject to be updated or change as the situation with COVID-19 unfolds, you will be notified of any update/change.

SAFETY GUIDELINES:

It is our priority to ensure the safety of our students, parents and staff. We are taking proactive measures to mitigate the impact of COVID-19. We are following CDC guidelines for everyone's safety. **We are asking ALL parents to wear a mask during drop off & pick up, even if you have been vaccinated. Our staff is required to wear a mask during school hours. Students 3's & up are required to wear a face mask OR face shield. We will take your child's temperature upon arrival.**

ENROLLMENT

Enrollment for 2022-2023 school year & summer program will be as follows:

From February 1st to February 4th enrollment will be open for current enrolled families.

From February 7th to February 11th enrollment will be open for families in our waiting list.

From February 14th to February 18st enrollment will be open for the community.

If for any reason a child needs to be withdrawn from 2022-2023 school year and/or summer program, you can do that before April 1st , after April 1st you are responsible to pay summer tuitions (June and July) and the months of August & September.

Illness & Communicable Diseases

Children who show signs of illness cannot be accepted. **We depend on parents to help us maintain this policy.** A child should be kept home when any of the following exist:

- *Temperature above 100F*
- *Respiratory illness*
- *Diarrhea: Loose or greenish bowel movement, which are not indicative of medication. The child SHOULD have normal bowel movement for 48 HOURS before returning to School.*
- *Vomiting or Nausea*
- *Untreated infectious skin patches*
- *Sore throat or difficulty swallowing*
- *Evidence of lice, scabies or other parasitic infection*
- *Communicable or contagious diseases*
- *Runny nose (Constant, clear or colored)*
- *Persistent cough*
- *Pain any area of their body*
- *Sore throat*
- *Rash*
- *Any skin infection – boils, ringworm, impetigo*
- *Pinworms*
- *Pink eye and other eye infections*
- *Yellow or green nasal discharge*
- *Scarlet fever*
- *Chicken pox, measles, etc.*
- *Stomach flu/Stomach bug*

If your child suffers from allergies, please send a Doctor's note, so we don't have to dismiss your child early.

Children MUST BE SYMPTOM FREE FOR 48 hours before they return to School and bring a Doctor's note stating that they are allowed to return to School.

If you have more than one child enrolled in our program, and one of them is sick, please kindly keep your other child(ren) at home.

If a child becomes ill at School, we will notify the parents to pick up their child immediately.
